

## School Overview

Imperial College London Mathematics School is a selective 16-19 school that opened in September 2023. We are a highly academic institution, and a STEM specialist school – we offer an A level-only curriculum consisting of Mathematics, Further Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry. We exist to support the development of the next generation of STEM leaders, and to build a STEM sector that is representative of wider society.

Our rigorous admissions process ensures that our cohorts are high achieving academically, and that they are strongly motivated to study with us and to pursue further study and careers in STEM. We offer these students a unique educational experience, leveraging our partnerships with Woodhouse College and Imperial College London. We also offer them a warm and inclusive community, where they can pursue their academic and personal passions to the full.

We are a small school and we are able to respond to our students as individuals – our current Year 13 cohort has 61 students, and our current Year 12 cohort has 66 students. We currently have 13 staff, including 10 teaching members of staff.

Our first cohort of students were incredibly successful in their A level examinations in Summer 2025 – recently published data from the DfE show that our cohort achieved the highest average A level grade in England, and our A level progress score of 0.89 was the second highest achieved within the state sector. We are looking for staff who can help contribute to and sustain this culture of excellence.
